1. These Regulations may be cited as the Insurance (Actuaries) Regulations.

Actuaries

2. Any person who is a Fellow of any of the institutes specified in the Schedule shall be an actuary for the purposes of the Act in respect of life business;

NOTICE TO GENERAL INSURERS INSURANCE ACT, CAP 142

Note: This Notice does not apply to captive insurers. This Notice replaces MAS 204 dated 23 Apr 1991.

APPOINTMENT OF ACTUARIES FOR THE PURPOSE OF INVESTIGATION INTO THE INSURANCE POLICY LIABILITIES OF GENERAL INSURERS

1 Under section 37, an insurer is required to have an annual investigation made by an actuary approved by the Authority into the valuation of its liabilities in respect of its general insurance policies.

Criteria

- 2 The actuary whom the insurer wants to engage to investigate its insurance policy liabilities should fulfill the following criteria:
 - (a) The actuary should have <u>at least two years</u> relevant actuarial work experience in the general insurance or reinsurance industry. The actuary should have held or holds a senior position responsible for determining the values of insurance policies or if a consultant, have had experience in a similar capacity.
 - (b) The actuary must be at least a Fellow of, and be of good standing in, an Institute recognised by the Authority. Examples of recognized institutes are - the Institute of Actuaries in England, the Faculty of Actuaries in Scotland, the Society of Actuaries and the Casualty Actuarial Society in the United States of America, the Canadian Institute of Actuaries and the Institute of Actuaries of Australia.

Administration

- 3 The Principal Officer is responsible for ensuring that the actuary is fit and proper to perform the work of valuing the company's insurance policy liabilities in accordance with the requirement of the Authority. He is expected to exercise due care and diligence in engaging such a person, including instituting checks of the actuary's credentials.
- 4 All companies are required to submit to MAS particulars of actuaries whom they want to engage using the format in Appendix A.
